

**Extension of Agreement of Academic Cooperation  
between  
The Regents of the University of New Mexico, United States of America  
and  
Concordia University, CANADA**

**Whereas:**

On August 12, 2013, Concordia University signed an Agreement of Academic Cooperation ("Agreement") with the University of New Mexico in the United States in order to strengthen the collaborative research, faculty exchanges, as well as student mobility programs between the two institutions.

**And:**

That the Agreement could be extended by the consent in writing by both parties for three-year periods.

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the section 5 "Duration of the Agreement" of the original Agreement signed on August 12, 2013, the participating universities desire hereby to record their consent that this Agreement be extended for an additional five (5) years effective as of the date at execution by the appropriate officers of each signatory institution. Subject to written notification, this agreement may be renewed as presently stated for a consecutive five (5) year period, revised by mutual consent or terminated with six (6) months of either party offering such notification. Clauses of the Agreement remain unchanged except as provided herein.

In witness hereof, the duly authorized representative of each institution agrees to the provisions of this document.


