COLLABORATION AGREEMENT

Hereinafter called «**POLY-MTL**»

Hereinafter called «**UNM**».

WHEREAS the common goal is to strengthen the existing collaboration links between our respective institutions;

WHEREAS preliminary discussions that were held between professors, researchers and scientists of both parties;

POLY-MTL and UNM HEREBY AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING :

Article 1

The purpose of the present agreement is to define the general conditions related to scientific, technical and academic collaboration between **POLY-MTL** and **UNM**.

Article 2

Each party is committed to collaborate with the other, in accordance with previous discussions and, insofar as is possible, by implementing the following activities:

- 2.1 Definition and realisation of coordinated teaching and research programs in various fields of engineering.
- 2.2 Sending of professors, researchers, experts and advisors for limited periods to :
 - a) participate in the development of scientific, technical and academic projects or provide their advice on such projects;
 - b) assist in the training of teaching personnel and organize training courses or workshops to this effect.
- 2.3 The exchange of documentation, the organization of conferences or other activities related to the dissemination of scientific and technical information (publications, etc.).
- 2.4 Exchange of students who are enrolled on a full-time basis at their home institution, to participate in academic and/or research activities which will be accredited by the host institution in order to fulfill part of the requirements to acquire a degree or a post-graduate degree in Engineering at their home institution. In this case, students will have to conform to the conditions and requirements stipulated by the host institution.

Article 3

The present agreement is not restricted to the fields of collaboration mentioned in Article 2.1 hereto and could also include other fields or other forms of collaboration as agreed to by both parties.

Article 4

Any particular project developed as a result of the present agreement must be subject to a specific protocol or amendment defining, among other things, the objectives of the project, the scope of expected activities, the time frame and any intellectual property issues.

Article 5

Until further notice, those responsible for ensuring the effectiveness of the agreement are Ms. Line Dubé, Director of the International Relations Office for POLY-MTL, and Mrs. Susi Knoblauch, program specialist in the Global Education Office (GEO) at UNM. Both parties will consult with each other whenever it is deemed necessary and will review and evaluate their common activities once a year, if possible.

Article 6

The present agreement implies no financial engagement from either party. Specific actions or programs requiring special financial arrangements will be subject to specific agreement.

Article 7

The present collaboration agreement having received the approval of the proper administrative authorities becomes effective for five (5) years from the date of signing of this document. Before the end of the third year, both parties will evaluate the results produced by the agreement. At the end of the said period, this agreement will be tacitly extended for one-year (1) periods unless one of the two parties has indicated, in writing and with an advance notice of six (6) months, that it wishes to terminate the agreement. Where such termination occurs, the provision of this Collaboration Agreement shall continue to apply to on-going activities until their completion.




