



## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO AND FUNDAÇÃO GETULIO VARGAS

This memorandum records the intention of the Regents of the University of New Mexico, located at Scholes Hall 144, MSC05 3300, 1 University of New Mexico, Albuquerque, NM 87131 USA, represented by its president, Robert G. Frank, and Fundação Getulio Vargas, an institution ruled by private law, registered in the CNPJ/MF under the n° 33.641.663/0001-44, located at Praia de Botafogo 190 – Rio de Janeiro/RJ – Brazil, represented by its president, Dr. Carlos Ivan Simonsen Leal, ID Card n° 47.221-D-CREA/RJ and CPF/MF n.° 441.982.057-87, by its Escola Brasileira de Administração Pública e de Empresas (FGV/EBAPE), as an indication of continued interest in the strengthening of ties between the institutions, and aiming at the establishment of one or more partnership agreements, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth herein.

- 1. At present this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made as a gesture of goodwill between the two institutions aiming at the development of links in the areas of:
  - a) Exchange of students for a given period through a recognized exchange program.
  - b) Exchange of university members of staff and faculty
  - c) Joint or collaborative research projects and events.
  - d) Exchange of documentation and research material.
  - e) International Modules for students.
  - f) Learning and teaching, including the development of a program which may lead to the delivery of a double degree.
  - g) Insertion of a link of FGV Escola Brasileira de Administração Pública e de Empresas and UNM Anderson School of Management on the Internet page of the partner institution, including special links related to specific common programs in development or implementation.
  - h) Exchange of consultation and co-ordination through their respective international relations offices on all kinds of cooperation programs.
- 2. Joint activities will be legitimized by the completion of a specific program agreement, signed by the institutions' respective legal representatives, establishing the conditions of the specific activity, especially when financial commitments are involved. Both parties understand that financial arrangements under this MOU will have to be negotiated and will depend on specific activities and the availability of funds. Any expense incurred by either of the parties would be subject to individual program agreements, on a case-by-case basis.
- 3. This MOU shall remain in effect for an initial period of three years, from the date of its signature. Thereafter it shall be automatically renewed from year to year. Either party may terminate this MOU by providing the other party with six months' written notice of its intent to terminate by e-mail or registered letter with acknowledgement of receipt. If termination takes place during the academic year, this MOU shall continue to be binding upon the parties up until the end of the current academic year.
- 4. The parties stipulate that the use of their respective brands, represented by their headings and logotypes, may only be used by a party with the previous and express authorization of the other party. This MOU does not authorize any one of the parties to express him/herself on behalf of the other, either verbally or in writing.

- 5. The signatories hereto affirm that they shall follow through, in good faith, on all actions arising from this MOU, whereby they shall do everything in their power to ensure that it shall be duly complied with. In the event of a disagreement, the parties undertake to settle directly and voluntarily the differences that may present between themselves and in every situation the Deans/President or their deputies shall be responsible for settling any conflicts that may ensue.
- 6. All notices required hereunder shall be in writing and delivered by a duly authorized representative of the party giving the notice and sent by email transmission to the following addresses. Either party may change its email address for notice purposes by providing prior written notice to the other party. Any notice sent by email shall be deemed to have been delivered at the time of confirmation of receipt.
