On the other hand, as you know, our agreement does not include a free Spanish course. Furthermore, it specifies that the UNM students should have a sufficient knowledge of Spanish in order to attend classes.

Finally, I am trying to explain you the difference between "curso" and "ciclo".
"Curso" would be the number of the year of the degree. For instance, if we have a degree of four years, a student can be in his first, second, third or fourth year. As you say, Robbie is currently in his first year at UNM.
Regarding the meaning of "ciclo", in the U. of Salamanca the degrees are divided in two cycles. If we have a degree of four years, the first two years would be the 1st "ciclo" and the two last years would be 2nd. "ciclo".
If we have a degree of five years, the first three years would be the 1st "ciclo" and the two last years would be the 2nd. "ciclo".
Finally, the Doctorate would be our 3rd. "ciclo".

We take this opportunity to wish you all of you a happy Christmas and the best for the coming new year.
