Extension of Exchange Agreement and Addendum Between

The Regents of The University of New Mexico, United States of America

And

Ewha Womans University, Republic of Korea

Whereas:

On December 19, 2014, The Regents of The University of New Mexico signed a General Cooperation Agreement and Specific Agreement for Exchange ("Agreements") with Ewha Womans University in order to strengthen student mobility programs between the two institutions.

And:

That the Agreements could be extended by the consent in writing by both parties for five-year periods. NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with Section 16 of the original Agreement signed on December 19, 2014 the participating universities desire hereby to record their consent that this Agreement be extended for an additional five (5) years effective as of the date at execution by the appropriate officers of each signatory institution.

And:

Addendums to the Agreement Specific to the Agreement of Exchange:

Section 8, subsection h – Financial Responsibilities of Exchange Students.

Strike:

At EWHA, exchange students are subject to a mandatory Health Center Fee at a cost of KRW 20,000 per semester. Those who apply for on-campus accommodation are subject to a mandatory Housing Administration Fee at a cost of KR W 60,000 paid only once at the beginning of the exchange period. These fees are subject to change without prior notice.

And Replace:

At Ewha, exchange students may opt to use the University Health Center by paying an optional fee of 23,200 KRW semester. The fee is subject to change without prior notice
